- 141 of 180 (78%) survivors in tower have been referred into the NKR Adult Respiratory Long Term Monitoring Service
  - 109 of 180 (61%) survivors in tower have received a lung function test (LFT)
  - Patients having had a LFT have also seen a respiratory consultant

- Patients not offered the service are either: out of country or not contactable
- Patients referred who have not had a LFT have either: DNA'd, seen a consultant but chose not to have a LFT, declined the service after referral, are out of area or are not contactable

- 81 of 124 (65%) survivors have been referred into the NKR Paediatric Long Term Monitoring Service
  - 40 of 44 (91%) survivors in tower have been referred
  - 34 of 44 (77%) survivors in tower have been seen

- 22 of 34 (65%) survivors in tower have been referred for a respiratory assessment
  - 16 of 22 (73%) survivors in tower referred for respiratory assessment have been seen
